### **Budai Salt Mountain**

The vast expanse of salt fields that once spread around Budai is gone now, leaving only the 7-meter-tall Budai Salt Mountain.

#### **Zhounan Salt Fields**

The Zhounan Salt fields have been renovated to resurrect the salt culture, and visitors are now able to get a taste of salt-field production, life, and ecology by personally experiencing the different processes accompanied by professional interpreters.

### Qingkunshen Fan-shaped Salt Fields

These fields, unique in Taiwan, were developed after an inland sea was filled in in 1975. They spread outward in a fan shape from salt-



#### **Dongshi Fisherman's** Wharf


Besides such attractions as green grasslands, white man-made beach, and wharf pathway, this area has a new photo hotspot: a twin-heart Tropic of Cancer marker. Here you can take a recreational fishing raft to Waisanding Sandbar, or enjoy scenes of the ecology and the sunset.



# **Budai Fishing Harbor**

This is the largest fishing harbor on the Chiayi coast, and the one with the most fishing boats and rafts. It is also a departure point for ferries to Penghu. It has now transitioned into a tourist fishing harbor with a tourist market where visitors

can buy fish and enjoy seafood. The Budai Yacht Harbor is nearby.





# Jiangjun Fishing Harbor

This is one of the largest fishing harbors in the Tainan area, with a holiday fish market, direct fish sales center, and visitor center. Here, visitors can buy specialty seafood products and savor fresh seafood cuisine, and view the frenetic afternoon auction at the fish market.

#### Chenglong Wetlands

Covering more than 100 hectares, these wetlands were once an expanse of farm fields that longterm inundation brought on by typhoon rains made it impossible to cultivate. Over two decades they have evolved into a wetland habitat

#### **Hukou Wetlands**



After being left fallow for many years, these former sugar-cane fields have evolved into poetic wetland landscapes that attract countless little egrets, night herons, and other water fowl.

This is Taiwan's first community-type painted village, with 18 3D paintings of deep-sea denizens such as sperm

whales, giant squid, and lantern fish. Here you will also find Taiwan's largest 3D street painting.

#### Haomeiliao **Nature Preserve**

With a vast windbreak forest, mangrove forest, and intertidal zone organisms, as well as beautiful ecological landscapes, this is a great place for wetland ecology education and observation that attracts hordes of

### **Black-faced Spoonbill Reserve**

The tidal land at the Zengwen River estuary is rich in benthic creatures and plankton that attract large numbers of protected blackfaced spoonbills to forage, leading to its designation as a reserve. A bird-watching pavilion allows convenient observation of these graceful birds, and an ecological exhibition hall introduces their life cycle and the wetland habitat.

#### Sicao Green Tunnel

The Green Tunnel stretches behind Dazhong Temple, the dense growth of mangroves on both sides making it a "mini-Amazon." Tourists cruise through the tunnel on rafts, with interpreters explaining this enchanting canal's water fowl and its plant and animal ecology.

### Qigu Lagoon

This lagoon, Taiwan's largest, is enclosed by Qingshangang, Wangzailiao, and Dingtou'e sandbars, and nurtures a rich plant and animal ecology. Tourists can tour the lagoon by recreational fishing raft to get a taste of the local fishery culture.

### **Boziliao Taiwan Mythology**



This area, with Boziliao's Putian Temple at its core. is noted for its humorous and playful 3D paintings that present a new nterpretation of figures rom Chinese mythology.

#### Former Residence of Hong Tong

The unschooled primitive painter Hong Tong, known as "The Picasso of the East," created richly colored works of magica allure that attracted attention in Taiwan and internationally. He lived in Xincuozai Community in Beimen's Kunjian Village; some of the community's walls are covered with his creations, making this a tourist hotspot.

#### Southern **Branch of the National Palace Museum**

This is the first large-scale national museum in Asia that combines the theme of "Asian art culture" with local cultural elements. The facility covers a large area, with a man-made lake, artificial wetlands, tropical garden, bankside stage, and other leisure facilities. The museum displays a rich array of artifacts and has all kinds of interesting exhibitions for you to visit.

# **Jinhu Wanshanye Temple**

This impressive edifice with exquisite wall paintings was founded in 1845 to pacify the souls of thousands of victims drowned by a huge tsunami. Its Water Spirits Festival, held in the sixth lunar month each year, is a unique religious activity.

**Daitianfu Temple** Devoted to five Wangye-plague gods-this is the largest Wangye temple in Taiwan. It is also a national historic site, and has been given three stars in the famous Michelin

#### Xinwen Jiaying Temple

This temple is devoted to the Jiulong Sangong—Three Lords of Jiulong. On the 27th day of the third lunar month every year it holds a unique "welcoming of the guest gods in the water" ceremony in which dozens of divine palanquins are carried into the water to welcome visiting deities.

This temple is devoted to the plague god (Wangye) King Li, and the Burning of the Plague God Boat ritual it holds every three years is known throughout Taiwan. The Wangye Cultural Gallery beside the temple exhibits artifacts related to the origins of the Wangye faith and its development in Taiwan, along with introductions to the temple's fairs and




